The certification ensures Safran customers experience no disruption in support and that new program opportunities can move forward without delays, reinforcing Safran's role as a mission-ready partner that customers can bring into sensitive programs without friction.

CMMC Level 2 requires organizations to implement and demonstrate adherence to the 110 security practices outlined in NIST SP 800-171, covering areas including access control, incident response, risk management, and system and communications protection. Achieving certification through an accredited third-party assessment confirms that Safran has the people, processes, and technology in place to protect Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) entrusted to the company by government agencies.

"We didn't wait for compliance to become a requirement — we moved early because our customers depend on us to be ready," said Craig Czajka, Chief Security Officer, Safran Federal Systems. "CMMC Level 2 certification is a reflection of our team's dedication and our broader commitment to investing in the capabilities our customers need. We take that responsibility seriously, and we'll continue to stay ahead so they never have to worry about whether Safran can support their objectives."

"This milestone changes the conversations we're able to have. It means we can pursue sensitive work without compliance being a gating issue — and for those who are already working with us, it's confirmation that Safran is a partner they can bring deeper into their projects without hesitation," said Trevor Dougherty, Vice President of Sales, Safran Federal Systems.
